Transportation Planner Vacancies

The Association of Central Oklahoma Governments, the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Oklahoma City Area Regional Transportation Study (OCARTS) area seeks highly motivated, skilled, self-starting professionals to fill three (3) key positions within the Transportation Planning and Data Services (TPDS) Division. All three positions require excellent analytical, communication and problem-solving abilities, as well as database management and GIS software skills.

- 1) Congestion Management Planning - The planner will assist the *Program Coordinator – Long Range Transportation Planning* in the development and implementation of regional initiatives associated with congestion management, Intelligent Transportation Systems, traffic incident management, and development of the long range transportation plan.
- 2) Socioeconomic Data and Bicycle/Pedestrian Planning - The planner will assist the *Program Coordinator – Socioeconomic Data* in analyzing and manipulating regional employment, land use, and other data as part of the agency's long range planning responsibilities. The planner is also responsible for the coordination of regional bicycle/pedestrian planning.
- 3) Intermodal Transportation Planning - The planner will conduct, review and coordinate intermodal transportation planning efforts related to transit, freight and airport access. The planner will also assist the *Special Programs Officer* in the development and implementation of the Public Participation Plan designed to ensure outreach and involvement of the public in the preparation of the long-range transportation plan and other ongoing MPO planning efforts.

NOTE: The positions will be filled at either the **Assistant Planner** or **Associate Planner** level, depending on qualifications.

Minimum Requirements:

Assistant Planner: Requires a Bachelor's Degree in Planning, Geography, or related field, plus one (1) year of professional experience. A Master's Degree in related field may substitute for the 1-year experience. Starting Salary Range: \$33,432 - \$42,660

Associate Planner: Requires a Bachelor's Degree in Planning, Geography, or related field, plus three (3) years of professional experience. A Master's Degree in related field may substitute for 1-year of experience. Starting Salary Range: \$37,992 - \$48,492
